Know Your Neighbor

1. Growing up, what were some of your proudest accomplishments?

Know God's Word

1. Reflect on the passage and in one or two sentences give a brief synopsis of the sermon last Sunday.
 - a. What point from scripture stood out the most to you?
2. Read Philippians 3:4-11
 - a. List all the points Paul lists for why HE could have such confidence in the flesh
 - b. How does he see those things now? Why?
 - c. Write out verse 9 in your own words.
 - d. Verse 10 says Paul wants "to know Christ."
 - i. List the things Paul gives as to what "knowing Christ" means
 - ii. How are you doing in regards to each item on this list?
3. Read Luke 19:1-9
 - a. The rich young ruler was asked to give up EVERYTHING. Paul lost "all things" in order to gain Christ. Why do YOU think Zacchaeus was ok with giving "half of his possessions" to the poor?
 - b. What were some similarities and what were some differences in these accounts?

Know How to Live

1. Of the four mentioned characteristics of "little ones" (trusting, humble, vulnerable, dependent), which one(s) is(are) the most difficult for you? Why?
2. Name at least one area in your life that you will begin to, or get better at, in becoming like a "little one" (trusting, humble, vulnerable, dependent).

Examples: being humble – I will be ok with driving Frank through the streets of Yorba Linda
Being vulnerable – I will share my thoughts and fears with my small group
